Robert Abel, Assistant Superintendent

- i. Reviewed the Brown Act and Bylaws reminding members to review their information, as all meetings will fall under the Act.
- ii. Discussed funding for the Gregg Anderson School; three Community Facilities District Bonds, Developer Fees, "Old" money from the previous bond, and approximately \$10,000,000 from the new bond (Measure WS)
- iii. Indicated the various fees/permits that must be paid prior to beginning construction.
- iv. These new bond funds cannot be used for the general fund.

Wayne Trussell, Construction Manager on the Gregg Anderson School project provided plans if the Committee had an interest in looking at them.

- v. Discussed that this will be a multi-prime project hoping for local bidders by dividing the project into smaller increments.
- vi. First bid will go out the end April, for the sitework.

Matt Buchanan, Vice President Flewelling & Moody Architects provided a presentation of the project for the Committee.
